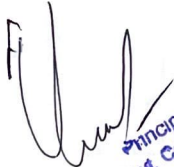

## REPORT ON THE FIELD TRIP, 2023

The Department of Botany, Tura Government College conducted an exposure trip for the students of 6<sup>th</sup> Semester, 2022 to Rongma Gitil, Kharkutta, North Garo Hills on 28.04.23 and back to Tura on the same day.

### **BENEFIT OF THE TRIP TO THE STUDENTS:**

Exposure trips give the student a welcome break in the routine. It erases the boredom of classroom lectures, and it awakens student's interest to learn and get new learning information.

The trip to Rongma Gitil benefitted the students by allowing them to learn about the Biodiversity and their *in situ* conservation based on their syllabus. This trip allows the student to experience a very different type of vegetation present in North Garo Hills district bordering Assam from the one in West Garo Hills.

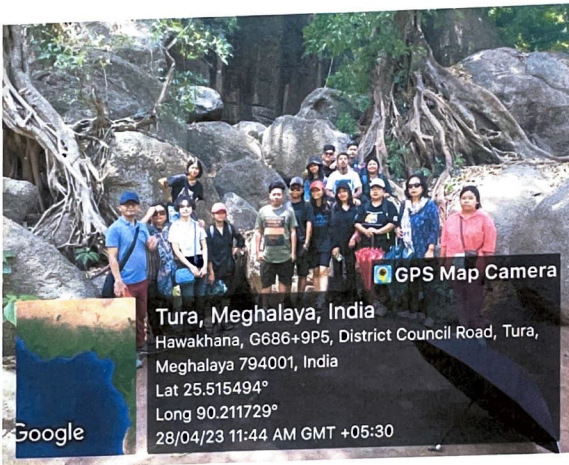
