### Report of the trip:

The Fifth Semester students of Geography Department organized the Departmental picnic cum one day Exposure trip within the local area at Sandi Dare ,(Waribok) in West Garo Hills on the 10<sup>th</sup> December,2021.

Sandi Dare ( waterfalls) is located at Waribok Village in Rongram Block of West GaroHills, Meghalaya. It is recently been inducted as tourist spot in GaroHills by the Tourism Department of Meghalaya state. This waterfall is located near Jengjal and it is of an hour journey away from Tura , the District headquarter of West Garo Hills. Sandi waterfalls is actually a two tier waterfalls .

In and around this waterfall the forest are preserved by the villagers from the villages which situated along the banks. So here, along the waterfall we found thick growth of plants of varied species. In the upstream there the villagers are practicing terraced paddy cultivation ,doing coffee plantation besides kitchen gardens. The villages are fully dependent on this river for water supply for drinking, washing, irrigation .

On the bedrock of the waterfall that lies on the upper stream there is a deep and wide sinkhole. According to one of the villager it was very deep, and he told us that villagers from seven villages together they tried to block this sinkhole by throwing boulders in it . And we were bound to believe him because when we looked into it ,saw boulders inside this sinkhole.

Thus, the visit to this place, surely will help the students to learn something about the biodiversity of this area , village life and the nature and work of river system.

## **DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY TURA GOVERNMENT COLLEGE**

The Project Work entitled **"EFFECT OF COVID 19 SHOCKS ON CROP PRODUCTIVITY AND HOUSEHOLDS ECONOMIC STATUS IN ROMBAGRE VILLAGE"** is a field work which examines the impact of the recent Pandemic on crop production and economic status of local farmers in Rombagre village in West Garo Hills District of Meghalaya. Specifically, it analyses the levels and determinants of household crop productivity in the village and their effects on socio-economic status. It is based on an examination of household survey data collected by the Students of Geography Department in the area of study.

The field work was conducted on 8<sup>th</sup>, April, 2022 under the supervision of Shri. Phrangshai Hynniewta along with the Head of Department and other faculty members.

The main focus of this field work is to focus more on the economic well-being of the local farmers, rather than just on production. With the recent pandemic that wreak havoc throughout the entire world, more so in the rural areas of this part of the world, the Socio-economic well-being of farmers must be a prime consideration of agricultural policy, besides production and growth. The aim of the Policy is, therefore, to stimulate attitudes and actions which should result in assessing agricultural progress in terms of improvement in the income of farm families, not only to meet their consumption requirements but also to enhance their capacity to invest in farm-related activities.

This project work has been broadly classified into four chapters and each chapter comprises of topics covering different Agricultural aspects of the study area.

Chapter I, gives the introduction to the whole project work. This chapter attempts to familiarize the location of the study area to discuss the statement of the problem, scope and objectives of the topic undertaken for study methods adopted and sources of materials collected for the study.



Chapter II, constitute of the analysis of the factors that determine the physical setting of the study area which include the soil, climate, location, distance of the study area. The underlying theme of this chapter deals with the description of the physiographic features; prevailing in the area which acts as the determinants to the agricultural composition of the study area.

The underlying themes of chapter III, involves discussion of the impact of Covid-19 in the study area, agricultural production and economic development.

Lastly, Chapter IV deals with the findings i.e., the Impact of Covid 19 on Agricultural productivity and on farmers Livelihood.
