TITLE: WORKSHOP ON PRESERVATION OF INDIGENOUS CULTURE AND TRADITIONS

**ABSTRACT:** The workshop was organized under equity initiatives funded by Rashtriya Uchhatar Shiksha Abhiyan, MHRD, Government of India on the 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 at Sadolpara Village. The programme was attended by thirty students of 5<sup>th</sup> semester from all streams. They were selected on first come first served basis. The resource person for the programme was Shri Senthing M. Sangma, Senior Lecturer in Garo, Don Bosco College, Tura.

**BODY:** The workshop was organized to help students to appreciate and preserve the rich cultural and traditional practices and values of the region. The programme started with a trip to Sadolpara Village at 8:00 A.M. Shri Senthing M. Sangma and a few village elders of Sadolpara Village explained the way of life, culture and traditions of the Garos. The inhabitants of this village are still Songsareks (Pagans) and the indigenous culture and traditions of the ancestors are still practiced even today. The students not only learned about the practices, life and cultural traditions but also got to witness the typical house constructions called the Nok A'chik, indigenous crafts as well as the totems erected for the spirits, and also learned about the sacrifices made for the spirits/Gods, chants and rituals of the Garos. The programme ended with a vote of thanks by Smt. Silmeritha P. Marak, RUSA Institutional Coordinator, Tura Government College.

3. Regarding workshop on "Food Processing and Preservation", members unanimously decided that
  - Shri Tinash Ch Marak, Proprietor M/s Tinash Agro Industries shall be the Resource Person as he is a successful local entrepreneur and also alumni of our college.
  - First half of the workshop shall consist of Lectures by
    - Shri Tinash Ch Marak, Proprietor M/s Tinash Agro Industries and
    - Shri Jiten Singh, HOD, Food Processing and Preservation, Tura Polytechnic
  - The post-lunch session shall consist of visit to M/s Tinash Agro Industries, to facilitate the participants to have first-hand knowledge
4. Regarding the expenses for the conduct of the workshop, it has been decided that an amount necessary for conduct of the two workshops shall be calculated and an application shall be submitted to Principal provide the RUSA Committee with necessary amount from the college funds, which shall be reimbursed later from RUSA account.
