AGREEMENT

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on this 17th day of May, 2017 at Tura

-BETWEEN-

AVENUES, SHILLONG a proprietorship venture (Service Tax Reg No AXQPS5891N) represented by its Proprietor and Managing Director Mr. Mark A R Laitflang Stone, son of Mr. Vincent Stone Sohliya, aged about 34 years, a resident of "Ai-Mar" MES Road, Rynjah, Shillong 793006, Meghalaya hereinafter referred to as "**Avenues**" on the FIRST PART.

-AND-

TURA GOVERNMENT COLLEGE, MEGHALAYA represented by the Principal, Tura Government College, Mr. Terence D. Marak, son of Milton S. Sangma, hereinafter referred to as "**Tura Government College**".

(Jointly hereinafter referred to as "the parties to this Deed")

WHEREAS Avenues is headquartered in Shillong, established in 2003 and is a forerunner in the capacity building space across North East India with cross domain expertise in Personal Development, Skills Mapping, Skills Gap/Training Needs Identification and Skills Development for Youth, Young Adults and the Unemployed. Over the last 14 years, the Avenues Academy at Shillong has trained over 15,000 youth and has been empaneled by the Government of Meghalaya and several colleges and

institutes for communications skills development, life skills and hospitality/service sector grooming programmes.

AND WHEREAS Tura Government College is a College located in Hawakhana, West Garo Hills, Tura -794001, Meghalaya, India, set up to impart quality education and promote the cause of higher education in the state and surrounding areas.

AND WHEREAS Avenues has approached Tura Government College with an offer to deploy training programmes for students of the campus with the expressed objective of enhancing Personal Development and improving the Communication Skills, Soft Skills and Career Skills of students at Tura Government College to which the said College has accordingly agreed and accepted the same and wishes to associate with Avenues on a long-term basis to achieve the same for all students on campus.

AND WHEREAS on the ACCEPTED proposal, this Deed is drawn and reduced to writing to avoid any confusion/ misunderstanding between the parties to this Deed under the term(s) and condition(s) stipulated herein below:

1. It is AGREED that Avenues shall work towards improving the overall Communication, employability and career readiness of students at Tura Government College through seminars and/ or workshops in soft skills, interview skills and other appropriate skill sets and accordingly shall deploy the said training initiatives for students of Tura Government College.
2. It is AGREED that the parties to this Deed shall engage in an on-going consultation to determine participant needs and training priorities of all the students for the duration of the partnership.
3. It is AGREED that the parties to this Deed will consult on learning outcomes of programmes as well as assignments and evaluations for students.
4. It is AGREED that all such agreement(s) being concluded/ fulfilled between the parties to this Deed prior to this instant Deed of Agreement are hereby terminated by mutual consent with effect from the date of execution of this instant Deed.
5. It is AGREED that the duration of this agreement shall be for a period of 6 (six) months with effect from the date of execution of this Deed of Agreement and on expiry the same shall be renewed by mutual consent of the parties to this Deed within 30 (thirty) days of its expiry.
6. It is AGREED that the training shall be delivered by trainers certified by Avenues in the areas of Personal Growth, Communication Skills and Soft Skills. The suggested Programme Outline designed for the initiative is enclosed herewith and marked as Appendix - A.
7. It is AGREED that Batch Schedules shall be arrived at in consultation between the parties to this Deed or their representatives, prior to commencement of each semester and same shall be agreed upon in writing.



It is AGREED that there shall be regular feedback both formal and informal. There shall be encouraged for students and the results of such feedback(s) received shall be shared on request made by Tura Government College.

It is AGREED that Tura Government College shall appoint a senior official / Faculty Member to act as a point of contact for this Programme, for the duration of this Agreement.

10. It is AGREED that Tura Government College will ensure a minimum 85% attendance from students enrolled for particular workshops.

11. It is AGREED that Tura Government College shall ensure that all department(s) and authority(ies) co-operate with the team of Avenues to allow smooth roll-out of the programme and shall ensure strict adherence to the scheduled agreed on for the batches.

12. It is AGREED that Tura Government College shall provide all necessary Training Infrastructure, facilities and necessary equipment at the Institution as recommended by Avenues from time to time. A basic list of requirements is enclosed herewith and marked as Appendix-B.

13. It is AGREED that all such printing costs of study materials and courseware for students / teaching aids / equipment for each training conducted by Avenues shall be borne by Tura Government College.

14. It is AGREED that Avenues shall ensure delivery of training and coaching for students as per modules listed in APPENDIX-A or agreed upon in consultation.

15. It is AGREED that Avenues shall ensure development of lesson plans, training content, module pedagogy and courseware/study material suited to each batch as per modules listed in APPENDIX-A or agreed upon in consultation.

16. It is AGREED that Avenues reserves the right to alter course content and curriculum as deemed fit to suit the competency and aptitude of batches at Tura Government College.

17. It is AGREED that Avenues shall conduct 10 seminars/ workshops at a date and time suited to the College's convenience.

18. It is AGREED that each seminar/ workshop shall be of the duration of 4 (four) hours and shall be conducted across two days.

19. It is AGREED that Avenues shall award Certificates to the students upon the successful completion of training modules.

20. It is AGREED that the fees for the programme amounting to ₹ 7,50,000.00 shall be paid in 2 (two) installments within a span of 3 (three) contiguous months from the date of signing of the MoU between Tura Government College and Avenues. While the first installment will comprise 75% of the total amount payable to Avenues in advance, the balance 25% shall be paid within 2 (two) months from the date of signing of the MoU.



It is AGREED that Tura Government College shall cover the cost of transportation, food and accommodation for the faculty members of Avenues to the tune of ₹ 10,000.00. This amount is subject to the programme being conducted within a contiguous span of 30 (thirty) days. Tura Government College further AGREES that in case the programme is conducted beyond the aforementioned 30 (thirty) contiguous days, all costs related to transportation, food and accommodation of the faculty members of Avenues, shall be borne by Tura Government College.

22. It is AGREED that all such payment shall be made via Electronic Transfer / Bank Demand Draft in favour of "AVENUES" and same shall be made payable at Shillong, Meghalaya. Details in APPENDIX C.

23. It is AGREED that Tura Government College agrees to pay any additional/ new regime of taxes as prescribed by the government during the course of the agreement with Avenues.

24. It is AGREED that the college may choose to enlist the services of Avenues to conduct an Employability Assessment and build professional resumes at ₹ 1,500.00 per student.


25. It is AGREED that in the event of any such untoward incident such as natural calamity/ disaster that might affect the training program of the students, the parties herein shall make all efforts to ensure the continuation and completion of the programme with suitable modifications.

26. It is AGREED that in the event of any dispute(s) between the parties to this Deed arising out of this agreement or in connection therewith the parties shall resolve the same by resorting to arbitration at Shillong, Meghalaya and in the event of arbitration the parties herein shall nominate an arbitrator each and both the nominated arbitrator shall appoint an umpire. The award of the umpire shall be final and binding on the parties.

27. The venue of the arbitral proceedings shall be at the offices of Avenues, Shillong, Meghalaya. The arbitral proceeding shall be conducted as per the provisions of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended upto date).
