
It may be stated that one small road near College Compound, which runs through our locality by the side of Late Mody Marak's residence is connected to the main road at Jerusalem near Tura Govt. College Girls' hostel. The students from different localities like Sampalgre, Wa'danang, Te'teng A'ja, etc. come by this road to attend classes. As such, this small road remains busy throughout the day from morning till evening due to heavy flow of pedestrians and passing vehicle of the local residents.

Of late, it has been noticed that some of the College /School students from neighboring institutions are seen gathering on this road near Late Mody Marak's Compound Gate every day during College and School hours and creating nuisance by blocking the way, throwing all sorts of rubbish like cigarette butts, empty bottles, plastic containers, etc. on the spot. In fact, this has been going on since some years back though we have not made any official complain to the concerned authorities so far.

We, the local residents in association with Hawakhana Church leaders are looking after the responsibility of cleaning drive every weekend as part of our mission to keep the area clean. Authorities of Tura college, schools urged to check students' activities

TURA: A complaint has been submitted to the Principal of Tura Government College at Hawabasa and to heads of other schools and institutions in the vicinity, where it has been alleged that certain students have been seen loitering along the path leading down from the main road near Mount Sinai School to the road near the Tura Government College Girls' Hostel, and indulging in evening.

Some residents of the area led by Ratanio M Saagma lodged a complaint on Tuesday and has urged authorities of these institutions to look into the matter.

"Of late, some students from the neighbouring institutions have been loitering and littering the place with cigarette butts, bottles and plastic containers. There have also been instances of teasing on female students which makes them uneasy while passing through," the complainant stated.

The complainant also informed that local residents along with the leaders of the Hawabasa Baptist Church have been organising cleaning drives every weekend as part of their initiative to keep the area clean. A signboard has also been put up by the Tura A & Development Committee, on the boundary wall as a deterrent to the general public not to misuse the public road as a recreational spot. GNLA hideout busted, Chinese weapon seized

TURA: East Garo Hills police commandos have busted a new camp set up by the banned GNLA outfit near Jakongge village, across the Simang river, on Tuesday after a fierce encounter in which a Chinese-made cache rifle was recovered.

Commandos raided the surrounding forests of Jakongge and Khokwage area, approximately 8 kms from Williamsnagar town to locate a hideout of the GNLA after a large group of armed rebels had been spotted crossing the Dorengage village three nights ago.

During the overnight search of the area on Tuesday, commandos came across the hideout near Jakongge village at around 5 AM and a heavy gun battle took place between the militants and the security forces.

"According to police, the firing was intense and lasted for almost thirty minutes. As many as twenty armed rebels are believed to have been present at the camp during the dawn raid. One of the pitched tents of the rebels also caught fire during the encounter."

It is strongly presumed that this was the same group which rechristened the abduction of two Ramrang traders from Chabhal weekly market and the murder of a surrendered rebel at Nongstak, last week.

From the encounter site a Chinese-made machine gun which looked like an Israeli Uz

machine gun was recovered after the rebels had fled. From the large layout of the camp there were as many as twenty rebels inside, said the police.

Police also recovered 73 detonators, Cordex wires and RC circuits meant for assembly of explosives, and GNLA documents from inside the rebel hideout. Casualties on the militant side is not being ruled out by police whose teams found blood spots inside one of the tents.

As many as two additional teams have been pressed into search operations following the encounter. Police are not ruling out

the presence of GNLA commander-in-chief Sohan D Shra in the camp at the time of the encounter since this was allegedly the same large group which had crossed over to Mdegnang village, 30 kms from Williamsnagar, on the night of September 20th.

The rebels had targeted a deterrer of their group, Tlangdi G Miam (28), who had surrendered to police a year ago. The deterrer had joined another group AMEF and surrendered to police in December, 2015 at Rongrang.

Tangdi had made a desperate attempt to escape the wrath of the GNLA by fleeing. (Contd on P-18)

Abducted GH trader released

TURA: A cloth merchant who was taken away to gun-poles by armed rebels from Rongrikkingre village of Chokpet during a market day last week has been released unharmed near Jakongge village on Monday morning.

The merchant, Bipi Saha, who hails from Sibhan border village of South Garo Hills was a frequent victim in the numerous weekly haats (bazar) in the district where he did brisk business in the sale of clothes and other material.

It was during one such trading day at interior Rongrikkingre last week that he fell victim to Ghoro rebels believed to be from the banned GNLA. Taking advantage of the absence of police presence on that market day, the rebels barged in just as trading was starting to kick off and took him away on foot into the forests.

Ransom is believed to have been paid by the family to the militants in return for the safe return of Saha. As per his statement of (Contd on P-18)
