The resolution approved in the meeting comprise of:

Restricting the consumption of Alcohol in College Premises: On Friday the 15th of April 2016 certain College boys were found consuming alcohol in college premises. The concrete evidence was gathered by one of the College Employee Shri. D. Ch. Marak who have manage to take a video of the students who was trying to flee after being caugth.

The committee have decided to take stern action against those students by either calling their parents or compelling them to sign an undertaking, failing which will lead to an expulsion from the institute.

2. Restricting the sale of tobacco/tobacco products in college Premises: The aforementioned was also establish from the reliable source that certain vendors were found selling tobacco/tobacco products like Cigarette, Rajnigandha, gutkha, pan masala and other intoxicate items which are injurious to the health and well-being of every individual people.

The committee decided that notice will be served at the earliest to every vendors vending on the college campus and if such vendors fail to comply with the notice, it would direct the authority to close down their shops.

3. Restricting the Usage of Mobile Phone in college Premises: The ubiquitous Mobile Phone has seeped into the lives of every student irrespective of the standards they are in. It is imperative for the committee to reflect on this over dependence on technological interventions which can have both positive and negative impacts. Therefore the Committee have decided that this may be brought to the notice to all the students not to use the mobile phones so that a more meaningful learning atmosphere can be created in the classroom which makes for a better learning environment.

The notice will be served restricting the use of mobile phone in college premises failing which the committee is empowered to seize their mobile phones and other similar gadgets, electronic devices etc.

- 4. Monitoring the Dress Decency: The convener stressed on monitoring a DECENT DRESS which should be worn by the students both boys and girls. For this reason, the committee have decided to adhere to the provision of clause 1 which was passed on 14th of June 2012.
- 5. Maintaining Cleanliness: Some members also carped out the need to reflect on the cleanliness of college premises as the present state is not in good taste. Principal also admitted that the lack of human resource was primary factor for which work cannot be allotted with smooth efficiency. Nonetheless, the Committee strongly convince the Principal to instruct the employees (Cleaners) to stay in a college premises and ensure their duties are being carried out.

The Committee has also decided to organize a campaign to bring awareness to the student's community the need to uphold and maintain the Do's and Don'ts which will be made available within the College premises.

7. Putting up sign Board, Navigational signs for each block and Parking lines: On the conclusion, the committee has also decided to put up the SIGN BOARDS along with the navigational signs for reach and every block so that a person concern can easily locate and identify each blocks.

The Principal also approves on this initiative and added to draw a PARKING LINES on the campus where the vehicles are being parked so that the vehicle is completely within any defined spot and in doing so, will remove the inconveniences of traffic congestion. For this matter, the committee will anticipate the allocation of funds for its implementation.


