





CONCLUSION:

From the feedback we can conclude the following

1. Curriculum delivery is well planned and effective: 80% of the students agree with the curriculum delivery mechanism while 20% have not given their opinions and decided to remain neutral.
2. Current Curriculum is need based: 100% of the students agree that the curriculum is right for the subject.
3. Curriculum is well updated: 40% agree that curriculum is well updated with the times, while 40% chose not to give opinion and remain neutral. The rest 20% did not agree that the curriculum is well updated.
4. Programme outcomes of the curriculum is well defined: 10% of the respondents agree that the programme outcome of the curriculum is well defined. 40% of the students agreed that the programme outcomes are well defined, while 30 % did not give their opinion and remained neutral. 20% of the students disagreed with these point.
5. Curriculum is having academic flexibility: 70% of the respondents agree that the curriculum ahs good academic flexibility. 20% remained neutral and the rest 10% strongly disagreed.

Overall on an average most of the respondents has good view of the curriculum and seems to be satisfied.

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

















CONCLUSION:

From the feedback we can conclude the following

1. Curriculum delivery is well planned and effective: 35% agree that the curriculum delivery is well planned and effective, while 50% agreed with this point. The remaining 15 % remained neutral

2. Current Curriculum is need based: 40% strongly agree that current curriculum is need based, while 45% agree on this point and the rest 15% choose to remain neutral.
3. Curriculum is well updated: 35% strongly agree that curriculum is well updated, while 50% agree and the remaining 15% does not have any opinion and choose to remain neutral.
4. Programme outcomes of the curriculum is well defined: 35% strongly agree that the Programme outcome in Physics Curriculum is well defined, 50% agree and 15% have no opinion and choose to remain neutral.
5. Curriculum is having academic flexibility: 40% of the respondents strongly agree to the curriculum that it has academic flexibility including 40% also agree with this point. However 20% could not give their opinion and choose to remain neutral.

Overall in the 3rd Semester, over 40% agreed with feedback. Overall on an average most of the respondents has good view of the curriculum and seems to be satisfied.

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

















Conclusion:

From the feedback we can conclude the following

1. Curriculum delivery is well planned and effective: While 15.4% strongly agreed with this point, 46.2% are of the opinion that curriculum delivery is well planned and effective. 30.8% remained neutral in their opinions, while 7.7% disagreed with this point.
2. Current Curriculum is need based: 69.2 agree that the curriculum is need based, 23.1 strongly agreed with this point, while only 7.7% choose to remain neutral.
3. Curriculum is well updated: 15.4% strongly agree with this point. 61.5 agree that the curriculum is well updated. 7.7% disagreed and 15.4% did not have any opinion.
4. Programme outcomes of the curriculum is well defined: 23.1% strongly said the programme outcomes of the curriculum are well defined and 53.8 agreed well with this point. 7.7% disagreed and 15.4% did not have any opinion and choose to remain neutral.
5. Curriculum is having academic flexibility: 46.2% agree and 23.1 strongly agree that the curriculum is having academic flexibility. 7.7% disagree and 23.1% did not have any opinion and remained neutral.
