Report on exposure trip to Mawlynnong- Dawki

The department of Zoology, Tura Government College, Tura, organised an exposure trip to Mawlynnong, East Khasi Hills district and Dawki, Jaintia Hils district, Meghalaya from 9th -11th of November, 2023. The trip was organised for the fifth semester zoology honours students. A total of 13 students attended the trip escorted by the teachers of the department. The trip was taken by a college bus, which left the college premise on the 9th of November 2023. During the trip the following places were visited:

- 1. Shnongpdeng: It is a small village, located a few kms away from Dawki. The village is nestled along the banks of the river Umngot, famous for its crystal clear waters. The calm and clear waers of the river make it a perfect spot for many water activities.
- 2. Dawki: It is a small town located in the West Jaintia Hills district. It is famous for its clear, turquoise waters and Umngot river which flows through it. The Dawki-Tamabil border crossing between India and Bangladesh is also located nearby.
- 3. Krangshuri falls: It is a stunning natural attraction located in the West Jaintia Hills district. It is renowned for for its mesmerising turquoise-blue waters and picturesque surroundings.
- 4. Mawlynnong: It is a picturesque village located in the East Khasi Hills district of Meghalaya. It has earned the title of " Asia's Cleanest Village". The village is famous for its community-driven cleanliness initiatives, where villagers actively participate in maintaining cleanliness of their surroundings.

Report on local field trip to Dabol Bheel

The department of Zoology, Tura Government College, Tura, organised a local field trip to Dabhol Beel for the fourth semester Zoology honours students on the 9th of March 2024. A total of 14 students attended the said trip, who were escorted by three teachers from the department. Dabhol Beel is located at a distance of 17 kms from Tura. It is lake-like wetland with a static water body and harbours a variety of living organisms. The purpose of the trip was to collect water sample for qualitative analysis of plankton in the practical class.

Relevance to the curriculum

One of the practicals of the fourth semester syllabus was to perform a qualitative analysis of plankton. Through this field trip, the students learnt how to collect water sample with the help of plankton nets attached to sample vials. From the water collected, the students analysed the sample using micorscopes and learnt to identify the different types of plankton during the practical class.





Report on study tour to Manas National Park, Sikkim and Darjeeling, April 2024

The department of Zoology, Tura Government College, Tura had taken the students of BSc. 6th semester Zoology honours on a study tour to Manas National Park, Assam, Sikkim and Darjeeling from the 23rd to 30th of April, 2024. A total of 13 students attended the trip accompanied by some teachers and lab bearers of the department.

Places visited:

1. Manas National Park: It is a national park, Project Tiger Reserve and an elephant reserve in Assam. The Manas National Park was visited on the 24th of April, 2024, where the students were rewarded with various animal sightings during the Safari. Eastern swamp deer, spotted dear, herd of elephants, bison, rhinoceros, wild buffalo, peacocks, stork, pheasants were some of the animals spotted in the park.

2. Himalayan Zoological Park, Sikkim: This zoological park is located in Bulbuley, East Sikkim. The park was visited on the 26th of April, 2024. It houses a variety of fauna species found in the Himalayas such as the Red Panda, Goral, Himalayan Palm Civet, Common leopard, Yaks, Porcupine, clouded leopard, peacocks and varieties of bird species.

3. Tsomgo lake and Nathu La: While in Sikkim, the department also visited the famous Tsomgo lake and Nathu La on 27th April, 2024. Tsomgo is a glacial lake, located at an altitude of 3753 m in East Sikkim. It is surrounded by steep mountains surrounded by snow for most of the year. Nathu La is a mountain pass that connects the Indian state of Sikkim with China's Tibet Autonomous Region.

4. Barbotey Rock Garden, Darjeeling: On the 28th the department with its team, headed to Darjeeling and visited two places, Barbotey Rock Garden and Orange Valley Tea Garden. Barbotey Rock Garden is a beautiful terraced garden located near Darjeeling, West Bengal. The place is known for its natural rock formations, cascading waterfalls and lush greenery.

5. Orange Valley Tea Garden, Darjeeling: It is one of the picturesque tea estates in Darjeeling, located amidst the rolling hills of the Himalayas. It offers stunning views of lush green tea bushes and the surrounding landscape. Darjeeling tea, famous for its distinct flavor and aroma is cultivated in tea estates including the Orange Valley Tea Garden.

After halting for a day at Siliguri, West Bengal, all returned to Tura on the 30th of April, 2024.

Relevance to the curriculum: The study tour was undertaken to fulfill a part of the prescribed syllabus for 6th semester Zoology honours. The study tour was a valuable and enriching experience having truly met the purpose of the trip. The students had an opportunity to explore both in-situ and ex-situ mode of wildlife conservation and gain knowledge on the presence of different kinds of faunal species in two contrasting regions having distinct geographical and climatic characteristics.


